Agenda Item #9A, – Emergency Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement-Follow-up Memo.

Robert H. Peterson, Director of Engineering, stated he highlighted the differences in the 2002 agreement and the agreement discussed at the June 7, 2010 Board Meeting. Mr. Peterson stated the highlighted text in red either explains the differences or is new text. Mr. Peterson stated the 2002 agreement did not contain exhibits; therefore all of the exhibit content is new. Commissioner Dravenstatt-Moceri stated he previously had concerns about who the Lansing Board of Water and Light uses as subcontractors. Commissioner Dravenstatt-Moceri stated he contacted the Lansing Board of Water and Light and the only time a subcontractor would be used is for pole replacement. Commissioner Dravenstatt-Moceri stated he is still concerned that on-call employees do not get to take a truck home. Commissioner Dravenstatt-Moceri stated the contract should state the Lansing Board of Water and Light on-call employee will take a truck home.

Agenda Item #11A, – CMAQ Application for Delhi Roundabouts.

Chair Guenther stated that CMAQ Applications need to be submitted by July 1, 2010. Chair Guenther stated the CMAQ funding needs to be applied for to see if it is available to build the improvements presented at the Delhi Township meetings last winter. Chair Guenther stated he directed staff to submit the applications on behalf of the township. Robert H. Peterson, Director of Engineering, stated these are only applications for funding. If the Board has reservations about the projects, at a later date, we can revisit the issue then.

Agenda Item #5, – Presentation of 2009 Audit by Abraham and Gaffney.

Steven Kirinovic, CPA, Abraham & Gaffney, P.C., presented the 2009 Ingham County Road Commission Audit. Mr. Kirinovic stated the respective financial position of the governmental activities and the major fund of the Ingham County Road Commission as of December 31, 2009, and the respective changes in financial position thereof for the year ended in conformity with accounting principles accepted in the United States of America.
