DETROIT STREET

RESURFACING TO BEGIN SOON

Detroit Street from 175 feet south of Kalamazoo Street to Michigan Avenue is scheduled to be resurfaced in the month of September, 2010.

Starting in the first or second week of September 2010, Detroit Street will undergo Hot In Place Recycling, (HIPR), which involves heating the existing pavement with a series of two truck-drawn heaters followed by scarifying, adding rejuvenating oil, re-screeding, and rolling—all in a relatively short, continuously moving process without removing the pavement.

This leaves a fairly coarse but drivable pavement texture, which will be covered by a new asphalt surface 1 to 2 weeks later.

HIPR normally moves past a given driveway in about 10 minutes after which the recycled pavement can be driven on. The street will be usable on at least one side at all times. HIPR on the entire street should be completed in one day assuming no problems occur.

Following HIPR, manhole covers will be adjusted as necessary, and then the street will be resurfaced with 2 to 3 inches of new asphalt about 1 to 2 weeks after HIPR. Resurfacing will also only take one day assuming no unforeseen problems.

No-parking signs will be posted if necessary a day or two before the work begins.

Please do not park any vehicles on Detroit Street the days it is to be recycled and resurfaced. Your street may have to be re-scheduled later if parked vehicles block the process.

The Ingham County Road Commission will manage this project, inspect the work to assure a successful outcome, and respond to any residents' concerns. Please contact the Road commission at 517-676-9722 between 7:30 am and 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday, if you have any questions or concerns.

There is no special assessment involved with this project. The Lansing Township / Road Commission Local Road 50/50 Match program is funding this project.

The total cost of this project is estimated at roughly \$57,000.
