Resurfacing To Begin Soon

The list of streets on the backside of this notice are scheduled to be resurfaced starting with spot curb repairs the week of September 7, 2010.

Starting on or about Wednesday, September 8, 2010, the listed streets will undergo Hot In Place Recycling, (HIPR), which involves heating the existing pavement with a series of two truck-drawn heaters followed by scarifying, adding rejuvenating oil, re-screeding, and rolling—all in a relatively short, continuously moving process recycling the existing pavement. This leaves a fairly coarse but drivable pavement texture, which will be covered by a new asphalt surface 1 to 4 weeks later.

HIPR normally moves past a given driveway in about 10 minutes after which the recycled pavement can be driven on. The streets will be usable on at least one side at all times. An entire street is normally completed in one day.

HIPR will be done on the listed streets (order not yet determined) until approximately September 18, 2010, assuming good weather and no unforeseen problems. No-Parking Signs will be posted if necessary on your street a day or two before the day HIPR is to be done on your street.

Following HIPR, manhole covers will be adjusted as necessary, and then the streets will be resurfaced with new asphalt about 1 to 4 weeks after HIPR. Once again no-parking signs will be posted if necessary a day or two before your street is resurfaced.

Please do not park any vehicles on the street on the days your street is to be recycled or resurfaced. Your street may have to be re-scheduled later if parked vehicles block the process. To be assured of not holding up progress, please avoid parking all vehicles on all listed streets between September 7 and completion of resurfacing expected in early October, 2010.

The Ingham County Road Commission will manage this project, inspect the work to assure a successful outcome, and respond to any residents' concerns.

There is no special assessment involved with this project. Funding for this project is coming from the following sources with approximate share as indicated:

Meridian Township's Road Millage – 65%

Meridian Township General Fund – 17.5%

Ingham County Road Commission - Act 51 Funds – 17.5%

The total cost of this project is estimated at roughly \$652,000.
