Mt Hope Road between Farm Lane and Hagadorn Road Will be fully Open to Traffic for this Weekend's MSU Football Game

The Ingham County Road Commission announces that the phase one of the Mount Hope Road project between Farm Lane and Hagadorn Road **will be fully open to traffic for the September 18th MSU (Notre Dame) home football game.** Mount Hope Road between Farm Lane and Hagadorn Road will now remain open to traffic. However, work will continue on Mount Hope Road between Farm Lane and Hagadorn Road after September 18th utilizing intermittent short-term single lane closures.

Mount Hope between Hagadorn and Okemos Roads remains closed to through traffic for construction until late October.

Completion of the top course paving of the entire project is scheduled to happen in early to mid November. The project is anticipated to be fully completed and opened to traffic before the Thanksgiving Holiday.
