

**INGHAM COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION
MASON, MICHIGAN**

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
2012 and 2013 PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION**

Pursuant to Public Act 150 of the Public Acts of 1976, the Board of Ingham County Road Commissioners is hereby giving notice that on **Monday, March 5, 2012**, a public hearing will be held for construction projects proposed by the Board to be accomplished in 2012 and 2013. The hearing will commence at **6:30 P.M.** in the Board Room of the Ingham County Road Commission's Austin E. Cavanaugh Administration Building located at 301 Bush Street, Mason, Michigan. The following is a list of the proposed projects, including the location and type of construction:

2012 Construction:

1. Okemos Road Enhancement – Jolly Road to Clinton Street. Street lighting, decorative sidewalk, plantings and furniture. Meridian Charter Township. Federal Enhancement Grant and Meridian Township funding. Estimated Cost: \$472,000.
2. Park Lake Road at Burcham Drive Intersection – Installation of a modern roundabout. Meridian Charter Township. Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) and ICRC funding. Estimated cost: \$670,000.
3. Washington Road – Holt Road to Willoughby Road. Road resurfacing and sidewalk installation. Delhi Charter Township. Federal Urban STP, and ICRC, Safe Route 2 School, and Delhi Township funding. Estimated Cost: \$760,000.
4. Willoughby Road – Washington Road to Beryl Street. Road resurfacing. Delhi Charter Township. Federal Urban STP, STP Safety, and ICRC funding. Estimated Cost: \$1,000,000.
5. Waverly Road at Willow Street Intersection – Signal modernization. Lansing Charter Township. Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funding. Estimated cost: \$100,000.
6. Waverly Road at Michigan Avenue Intersection – Signal modernization. Lansing Charter Township. Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funding. Estimated cost: \$100,000.
7. Haslett Road – Park Lake Road to CN Railroad. Road resurfacing. Meridian Charter Township. Federal Urban STP and ICRC funding. Estimated Cost: \$1,230,000.

2013 Construction:

1. Zimmer Road at Grand River Avenue Intersection – Intersection approach widening and resurfacing. Williamstown Township. Federal STP Safety and ICRC funding. Estimated Cost: \$200,000.
2. Zimmer Road – Grand River Avenue to Haslett Road. Road reconstruction. Williamstown Township. Federal Urban STP, STP Small Urban, and ICRC funding. Estimated cost: \$1, 530,000.
3. Zimmer Road Bridge - Over the Red Cedar River - Bridge Replacement. Williamstown Township. Federal and State Local Bridge Program and ICRC funding. Estimated cost: \$1,300,000.

4. Van Atta Road Bridge – Over the Red Cedar River - Bridge Replacement. Meridian Charter Township. Federal and State Local Bridge Program and ICRC funding. Estimated Cost: \$985,000.
5. Noble Road Bridge – Over Doan Creek - Bridge Replacement. Leroy Township. Federal and State Local Bridge Program and ICRC funding. Estimated Cost: \$500,000.
6. Holt Road Bridge – Over Deer Creek (Wheatfield Township), Gramer Road Bridge – Over the Red Cedar River (Leroy Township), Webberville Road Bridge – Over the Red Cedar River (Leroy Township) - Bridge Rehabilitation. Federal and State Local Bridge Program and ICRC funding. Estimated Cost: \$668,000.

The proposed construction is scheduled to be performed during the 2012 and 2013 construction seasons. Acquisition of right of way, if required, will be completed before construction of the projects, provided the Board of Ingham County Road Commissioners approves the project.

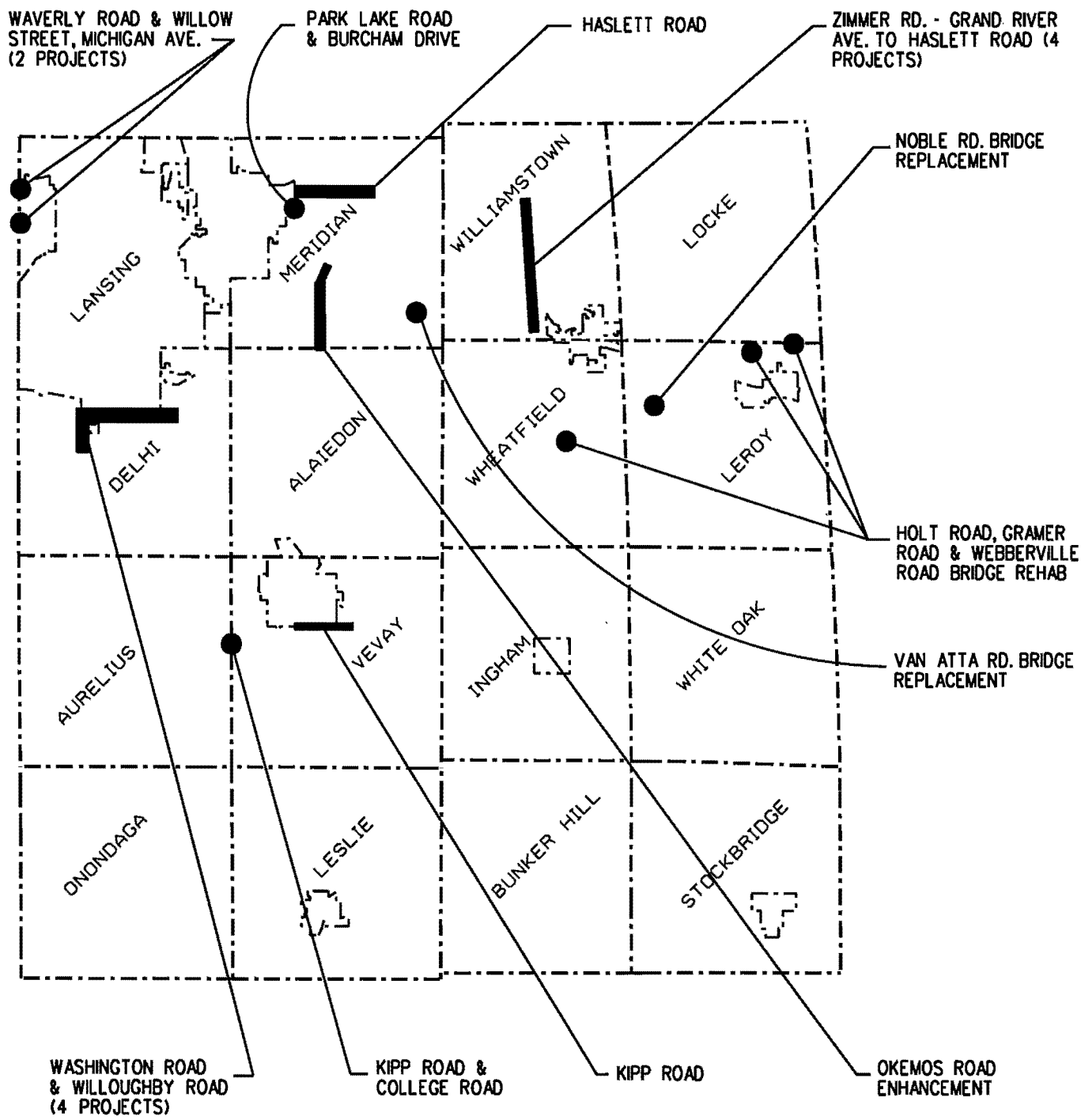

The Ingham County Road Commission will provide necessary reasonable auxiliary aids and services, such as interpreters for the hearing impaired and audio tapes of printed materials being considered at the meeting for the visually impaired, for individuals with disabilities at the meeting upon five (5) working days notice to the Ingham County Road Commission.
