## **PINE TREE ROAD**

### **RESURFACING TO BEGIN SOON**

**Pine Tree Road from Keller Road to Dell Road is scheduled to be resurfaced in the months of September and October, 2010.**

**Starting in the last week of September, 2010, the pavement on Pine Tree Road will be pulverized, which involves grinding the existing pavement into a gravel base. This will then be graded and paved with 3 to 3.5 inches of new asphalt. The north half mile from Willoughby to Dell Roads will have paved shoulders similar to the south half mile when completed.**

**Although Pine Tree Road will be closed to through traffic during construction, residents and visitors will be able to get to and from their homes at all times from one end of their block or the other depending on exactly where work is occurring at the given time.**

**Between pulverizing and paving, Pine Tree Road will resemble a compacted gravel road. Pulverized material generally does not create dust. Nonetheless, dust will be controlled at all times and the surface will be kept well graded.**

**Following pulverizing, the road will be resurfaced with 3 to 3.5 inches of new asphalt. Resurfacing will be done in two steps to allow adjustment of manhole covers between paving the two layers of asphalt. Paving each layer of asphalt should only take one day assuming no unforeseen problems. The whole project should only take 2 to 3 weeks assuming no unforeseen problems.**

**The final surface of the pavement will likely be several inches higher than the existing pavement. Thus asphalt approaches will be placed at all driveways following the main road paving to provide a smooth surface into all driveways.**

**The Road Commission will also install driveway culverts and ditching where necessary to improve drainage—predominately in the north half mile between Willoughby and Dell Roads. Mailboxes will be moved back as necessary.**

**The Ingham County Road Commission will manage this project, inspect the work to assure a successful outcome, and respond to any residents' concerns. Please contact the Road commission at 517-676-9722 between 7:30 am and 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday, if you have any questions or concerns.**

**There is no special assessment involved with this project. The Delhi Township / Road Commission Local Road 50/50 Match program is funding this project.**

**The total cost of this project is estimated at roughly \$215,000.**
