WAVERLY ROAD RECONSTRUCTION NOTICE

July 27, 2010

Dear Property Owner:

The anticipated road construction on Waverly Road from Columbia Road to Pleasant River Drive is scheduled to begin the week of August 2, 2010. The low bid Contractor is Michigan Paving and Materials, Inc. (Spartan Asphalt), Lansing MI. Pending award of the construction contract by the Michigan Department of Transportation, we expect construction and detour signing will be installed early the week of the 2nd, with actual construction activities commencing shortly thereafter. Work will begin with excavation of the two hill cut areas at Wilbur Hwy and south of Burke Hwy, as well as repair work on the bridge over the Grand River.

The project will generally consist of grinding the existing road up into a gravel-like material, adding a liquid stabilizing agent and using that material for pavement base, and repaving over that base material. The finished road will have two travel lanes with paved shoulders outside of the travel lanes. We expect project construction to be completed by the end of October this fall.

Detour signing will be placed because Waverly Road will be closed to through-traffic during much of the reconstruction. Through-traffic is traffic whose origin and destination are outside the project limits and where the vehicle is "just passing through" the work zone. Waverly Road will be open for local traffic during the entire project. Local traffic is traffic that has an origin or destination within the work zone, such as homeowners, church attendance, mail service, garbage pick-up, and deliveries etc. Please be assured that you should always be able to access your property from at least one direction. The Road Commission will make every effort to minimize inconvenience to you, and we will have staff on site during construction activities if questions or concerns arise.

Please be aware that the Ingham County Road Commission and the Contractor will coordinate with the Post Office for mail delivery during project construction. If temporary relocation of your mailbox is necessary, the Post Office and/or your mail carrier will direct the Road Commission where to place your mailbox during construction.

Just a reminder, your road frontage may contain valuable private appurtenances such as landscaping, irrigation systems, culvert headwalls, and other posts, gates, or fencing within the construction grading limits. When such appurtenances are within the road right-of-way (typically measured 33 feet from the centerline of Waverly Road), the Road Commission requests that the property owner relocate these items outside the road right-of-way, before construction begins. The Road Commission is not responsible for replacement or salvage of these items unless they are outside the road right-of-way or within an executed grading permit or easement.
